Today at 11.30 in the Aula of Law and Administration Faculty of UMCS, our class 1hi took part in the project called “Klasa Patronacka”. The first meeting was with Ms. Ewa Bondaruk who was talking about her work as a public prosecutor. Later we had a meeting with a lawyer Mr. Krzysztof Sokołowski, who gave a vivid presentation entitled “ Constitution for Everyone” (“Konstytucja dla każdego”). Mr Sokołowski presented a case study that illustrated how the rights guaranteed in Constitution work on everyday basis. hanks to his presentation we became more aware of the importance this document has for every citizen in Poland.



The third meeting was with Mr. Konrad Łakomy and his colleague. We learnt about the shortcomings and opportunities of working as a solicitor. My class was the most active during this presentation - we asked some questions related to some legal issues concerning everyday life.
